



Dr. Mary K. Schmidl is a Past President of the Institute of Food Technologists (IFT) and is currently Chair of the Scientific Council of the International Union of Food Science and Technology and Adjunct Assistant Professor at the University of Minnesota.

She is the former Director of Research, Clinical Division of Novartis Nutrition a subsidiary of Novartis, Inc. which manufactures special dietary and medical food products.

Prior to Novartis, Dr. Schmidl worked for Cutter Laboratories a subsidiary of AG Bayer.

She has commercialized more than 75 new products.

Dr. Schmidl has served in many offices of the Nutrition Division of IFT including Chair and was elected as a member of the IFT Executive Committee. From 1994-99 she served as Assistant Treasurer of the IFT before becoming the 61st President. She has authored and co-authored over 50 refereed research papers, magazine articles, patents, book chapters and books. Dr. Schmidl received the Babcock Hart Award for Nutrition in 1993 from IFT and has been elected a Fellow of IFT, IFST and IUFoST.

In 1995 she received the Award of Distinction from University of California at Davis and most recently (2008) the "Friendship Award" from the Chinese Institute of Food Science and Technologists for the development of international relationships to foster global cooperation in food science.
